Statement of Cooperation

1. I pledge my cooperation and support to the staff and administration of the Mountain Valley Christian Academy in the training and disciplining of my child. I recognize the need to participate in prayer, service, and annual giving in order to properly support the school ministry.
2. I pledge my cooperation to help by volunteering 20 hours per school year or contributing \$500 in lieu of volunteer time. I also understand it is my responsibility to have the attached form signed and turned in. I also agree to pay any fraction of the \$500 that has not been fulfilled in total hours.
3. I realize that, as a parent, I must be in harmony with the rules and policies of the school. The teachers and administration are hereby given full discretion in the disciplining of my child. Such discipline may include the issuing of demerits, detentions, suspensions, Saturday school, and expulsion from the school.
4. As proof of cooperation, I will attend parent-planning meetings. I pledge my loyalty to MVCA and will, in a spirit of harmony, take questions and criticisms to the proper school authority.
5. I give my child permission to participate in all school-sponsored activities including sports and trips off campus.
6. I understand it is the school's policy to make no refunds on registration or placement fees.
7. I understand that financial obligations must be met consistently. I am aware that neither report cards nor transcripts will be issued to students whose accounts are 15 days or more past due. I also understand that if my account reaches 30 days past due, my child will be suspended from class until the account is brought current.
8. I appreciate the expectations of MVCA that its students act like the children of The King. The scriptural standards for living harmoniously in God's family include:
 - Respect for God and His Word
 - Respect for authority
 - Respect for property
 - Respect for oneself
9. I pledge my cooperation in bringing my child to school on time each day unless an emergency prevents me from doing so.
10. In signing this statement I attest to the truth that parents play a vital role in the successful operation of the school. As parents and teachers work together, children will grow strong in the bond of such a union.
